



Ranking methodology 2025

| Top women, men and mixed category team members get the same amount of points | The maths are not that easy but you get a chance to read how it works | Whether you are first or last, you will get points to brag about |

Races are not treated equally.

Winners of each category (Women, Men and Mixed) of the Ötillö World Championship get 800 points.

Winners of Ötillö World Series races get 600 points.

Winners of Cote Vermeille, Rockman and Troll Enez get 500 points.

Winners of all other races get 400 points.

Easy so far?

The points are then distributed against a cubic curve (x^3 function) so that the winners of each category get the maximum points and the last finishers of each category get 0.

Let us take an example:

If the maximum number of points was 400 for a specific race. And there was 20 finishers in the women category. Below is the parabolic distribution of points. Ranking in grey corresponds to points in white i.e. the 1st Womens team gets 400 points, the 8th 101 points, etc.

| 10 | 59 | 20 | 0 |

Finally, to calculate the number of points during the season, you add up your 5 best results for individuals and your 4 best results for teams.
