



Ranking methodology 2026

Gender equal	Transparent	For all
Top women, men and mixed category team members get the same amount of points	The maths are not that easy but you get a chance to read how it works	Whether you are first or last, you will get points to brag about

Races are not treated equally.

For a specific race, winners of each category (Women, Men and Mixed) are getting points based on the following:

- We add up the individual TSR ranking points of the previous year (2025) for both members of the top 6 finishing men teams, the top 5 finishing mixed teams and the top 4 finishing women teams in 2026
- We then multiply that number by 0.003 and add 340
- The resulting number P, rounded up, is the number of points for that specific race in 2026

Then the other finishing teams get numbers distributed along an inverse cubic curve.

For example, if P=420 and the number of finishing teams in the category (men, mixed or women) is 30, then the teams are getting the following points:

Finally, to calculate the number of points during the season, you add up your 5 best results for individuals and your 4 best results for teams.
